ELIGIBLE MINORS SHOULD OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM THEIR PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN THIS CONTEST.

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN A PRIZE. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

2. **Contest Overview:** The “Amazingness Talent Show Contest” (the “Contest”) is a contest (the “Contest”) in which participants are provided the opportunity to create and submit an original video featuring themselves showcasing a personal talent. Videos will be reviewed and judged each week by Sponsor (hereinafter defined) to determine the three (3) top weekly finalists ((the “Finalists”) whose entries will be aggregated in an online gallery to be voted on by the public (each, a “Weekly Voting Period”). Each Weekly Voting Period will yield one (1) weekly winner (each a “Weekly Winner”) for a total of eight (8) Weekly Winners. Following the final Weekly Voting Period, there will be a grand prize voting period (the “Grand Prize Voting Period”) wherein the public will vote on their favorite Weekly Winner. The Weekly Winner who receives the most votes shall be deemed the grand prize winner (the “Grand Prize Winner”).

3. **Entry Periods:** The key dates for the Contest are as follows:

Contest Entry Period: Entries for the Contest must be received between 3:00:01 PM Eastern Standard Time (“EST”) on December 1, 2017 and 2:59:59 PM EST on January 26, 2018 (the “Entry Period”).

Judging Period: Judging of Eligible Entries (hereinafter defined) to determine the Finalists shall take place each week by 1:00 PM (EST) on the following dates: December 8, 2017, December 15, 2017, December 22, 2017, December 29, 2017, January 5, 2018, January 12, 2018, January 19, 2018 and January 26, 2018 (the “Finalists’ Judging Period”).

Weekly Voting Periods: Voting to determine the Weekly Winners shall take place as follows:

Grand Prize Voting Period: Starting at or around 1:00 PM (EST) on January 26, 2018 and ending at 5:00 PM (EST) on February 1, 2018

Grand Prize Winner Announcement: At or around February 2, 2018.

4. **Eligibility:** The Contest is open to legal residents of one of the fifty United States and the District of Columbia who are at least fourteen (14) years of age or older at time of entry. If Entrant is not the age of majority in the jurisdiction in which he/she resides, Entrant must obtain parental or legal guardian consent to be eligible to enter). Entrant must not be, during Contest Period or at time of prize fulfillment, acceptance and/or participation, a party to any agreement with any third party that might interfere with Entrant’s participation in the Contest and /or

acceptance of any prize awarded. Employees and their immediate families (*i.e.*, parents, spouse, children, siblings, grandparents, step parents, step children and step siblings whether or not living in the same household) of Viacom Media Networks, a division of Viacom International Inc. (“VMN” or “Sponsor”), Seven2, and their respective parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, sponsors, advertising agencies, third party fulfillment agencies, agents, employees, officers, directors, successors and assigns (the foregoing, collectively, with Sponsor, the “Contest Entities”) are not eligible to enter Contest. By participating in this Contest, Entrants agree to: (a) be bound by these Official Rules and by the interpretations of these Official Rules by Sponsor, and by the decisions of Sponsor, which are final in all matters relating to the Contest; (b) release and hold harmless Contest Entities against any and all claims, injury or damage arising out of or relating to participation in this Contest and/or use or misuse or redemption of a Prize (as term is defined hereinafter) and for any claims based on publicity rights, defamation, invasion of privacy, copyright infringement, trademark infringement or any other intellectual property related cause of action; and (c) acknowledge compliance with these Official Rules. Sponsor reserves the right, in its discretion, to disqualify any Entrant who is under a third party agreement which Sponsor deems as contradictory to the nature of this Contest.

5. To Enter: Visit <http://www.mtvsamazingness.com> (the “Contest Website”) at any time during the Entry Period and follow the on-screen prompts for entry instructions. . Entry into the Contest requires that the Entrant create and upload an original video (the “Video”) of himself/herself as a solo performer demonstrating his/her talent. Videos must not exceed sixty (:60) seconds in length and must be uploaded in 16:9 aspect ratio. Videos must not contain any music that is not the original music of Entrant. Any Video that contains any music copyrighted by a person or entity other than the Entrant will be disqualified. Once Entrants have accessed the Contest entry form they must: (a) follow the online instructions to fill out all required fields on the online entry form completely and accurately, (b) upload their Video as instructed, in a format and file size specified on the Contest Website, (c) electronically agree to Sponsor’s privacy policy [<http://www.mtv.com/legal/privacy>], Terms of Use [<http://www.mtv.com/legal/terms>] and these Official Rules and (d) submit the entry as directed to count as one (1) “Entry”. The Video must be comprised only of original elements created by Entrant and may not contain elements which are/have been created, developed, copyrighted, trademarked and/or patented by third parties (including, without limitation, music) or which are owned or subject to proprietary or licensing rights of or by an entity other than Entrant(s) personally and in their individual capacity(ies). The individual responsible for submitting an Entry will be deemed to be the “Entrant”. Entrant represents and warrants that all persons appearing recognizably in the Video are at least eighteen (14) years of age and have granted consent to be videotaped and appear within the Video for the purposes contemplated under the Contest. Sponsor reserves the right to request proof of these consents in a form acceptable to Sponsor from any Entrant at any time. Any persons appearing in the Video other than the Entrant who has submitted the Video are not entitled to receive a prize. Any Video that does not meet the requirements set forth in these Official Rules will not be accepted or will otherwise be disqualified.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ANY AND ALL VIDEOS AND METADATA SUBMITTED FOR THIS CONTEST MAY BE PUBLICLY VIEWABLE.

By entering this Contest, Entrants agree to abide by and be bound by Sponsor’s Terms of Use [<http://www.mtv.com/legal/terms>] if you do not agree to Sponsor’s Terms of Use, do not enter the Contest or otherwise use the Contest Website. In the event of a dispute over who submitted a winning entry the authorized subscriber of the e-mail account used to participate in this Contest at the actual time of entry, will be deemed to be the Entrant. The authorized account subscriber is defined as the natural person who is assigned an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization (e.g., business, education, institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. There is a limit of one (1) entry per person. All Entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. Creating multiple accounts in order to exceed the limits on Entries permitted by these Official Rules may result in the disqualification of such Entries.

Entrant agrees that: (i) he/she has all rights to the contents of the Video and all components thereof, and that Entrant has obtained all rights, consents and permission, including but not limited to those of persons participating/appearing in the Video, necessary to grant the rights granted herein; (ii) the Video does not and will

not violate any law, statute, ordinance or regulation; (iii) the Video is free and clear of any liens or claims with respect to the use of the Video in the manner authorized herein and will not give rise to any claims of infringement, invasion of privacy or publicity or claims, or infringe on any rights or interests of any third party, or give rise to any claims for any payment whatsoever, including but not limited to claims for re-use fees or residuals; and (iv) the Video is not and will not be defamatory, trade libelous, pornographic or obscene.

Entrant agrees that by entering into this Contest his/she is granting Sponsor (and any and all of Sponsor's subsidiaries and affiliates and affiliated broadcast stations and networks, successors and assignees and licensees) the non-exclusive, worldwide irrevocable right and license, but not the obligation, to exhibit, broadcast, copy, reproduce, encode, compress, encrypt, incorporate data into, edit, dub, superimpose, rebroadcast, transmit, record, publicly perform and distribute and synchronize in timed relation to visual elements, the Videos and/or any portions or excerpts thereof, in any manner, an unlimited number of times, in any and all media, now known or hereafter devised for any purpose, throughout the universe, in perpetuity. Sponsor may use the Videos to advertise, promote and publicize, the Contest, Sponsor, VMN's worldwide programming services and/or VMN's websites in any and all media throughout the universe and may authorize others to do so; such advertising, promotion and publicity may include portions and excerpts, in addition to cut-in, synchronized, dubbed and superimposed versions of the Videos. The undersigned acknowledges that Sponsor may use the Videos in accordance with the permission granted herein without any payment to the undersigned or any third party.

Entrants agree that Videos **shall not** contain, include or involve any of the following:

- Obscenity
- Infringing music or other content
- Crude, vulgar or offensive pictures, depictions, images, language and/or symbols
- Gang signs or symbols
- Violence
- Explicit sexual activity
- Nudity
- Lip synching
- Team uniforms
- Illegal drug or alcohol use
- Commercial products (*e.g.*, clothing, toys, food) and/or their trademarks, brands, logos or endorsements
- Unauthorized trademarks and copyrighted material (*e.g.*, music, fake Oscar statuettes, etc.)
- License plates, phone numbers, personal addresses – physical or email or otherwise
- Website or web page links
- Derogatory characterizations of any ethnic, racial, sexual or religious groups, humiliate other people (publicly or otherwise), any assault or threatening of others
- Trespass or the violation of other people's rights or property
- Illegal (*e.g.*, discriminatory, harassing) or inappropriate activity, behavior or conduct (*e.g.*, inflicting emotional distress)
- Conduct or activities in violation of these Official Rules
- Any other content, display, materials and/or images that is or could be considered inappropriate, unsuitable or offensive, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion

Videos containing content which endorse or condone illegal drug use or alcohol abuse are not allowed. Narcotic addiction and alcohol abuse should only be depicted as self-destructive, anti-social behavior. Videos should not promote, glamorize or show as socially acceptable, the use of illegal drugs or the abuse of legal drugs. Videos containing explicit, graphic or excessive sexual activity are not allowed. When sexual themes are key to the meaning or intent of a Video they must be depicted with consistent regard for commonly accepted standards of taste and propriety. Videos containing gratuitous violence are unacceptable. Violence, if depicted, must be essential to the development of a theme, plot or concept of the Videos. Violence may not be used to stimulate the audience or to invite imitation, nor may it be shown or offered as an acceptable solution to problem or conflict. Exceptional

care must be taken in instances where women and children are victims of, or are threatened by, acts of violence. Language and themes contained in Videos will be evaluated by Sponsor based on content and societal acceptability.

Sponsor is not obligated to, use, publish, display or broadcast any Videos submitted with an Entry. Entrant acknowledges that Sponsor will rely on such Entrant's agreement and compliance with these Official Rules when Entrant submits or attempts to submit the entry. Sponsor reserves the right to reject any entries that it deems, in its sole discretion, to violate any of its "Standards and Practices" policies or the terms and conditions set forth in these Official Rules. Sponsor may modify or edit any materials related to a Contest entry or request Entrants to do so, so that such materials meet such guidelines.

In submitting an entry into this Contest, each Entrant agrees to, confirms and represents to Sponsor that neither he/she nor anyone else has engaged or taken part in (or induced or encouraged anyone else to do so) in any activity or conduct in connection with this Contest that: (aa) may or is likely to harm or create a risk of harm, physical or mental injury, emotional distress, death, disability, disfigurement, or physical or mental illness to any person, other living thing or any property; (bb) may or is likely to create a risk of any other loss or damage to person, living things or property; (cc) is or may constitute a crime, unlawful or non-consensual activities (*e.g.*, conduct that could lead to criminal prosecution), tortious conduct (*e.g.*, conduct that could lead to civil prosecution) or the violation or infringement of the rights of any other party; or (dd) violates any of the terms or conditions of these Official Rules.

All entries submitted in accordance with these Official Rules shall be collectively hereinafter referred to as the "Eligible Entries". Incomplete or inaccurate entries are void.

6. Finalists' Selection and Notification. During each of the Finalist Judging Periods, Eligible Entries will be reviewed and judged by Sponsor on (a) originality, (b) creativity and (c) spirit/enthusiasm (collectively, the "Judging Criteria") to select each of the (15) Finalists. The final determination of the Finalists and the application of the Judging Criteria shall be in the sole and absolute discretion of Sponsor. To the extent permitted by law, the Released Parties Sponsor disclaim any liability from, and all Entrants, whether or not a Finalist or a potential Winner, agree to waive, any claims against the Contest Entities and Sponsor relating to the judging, voting or awarding process. Sponsor reserves the right to delay the announcement of the Finalists in its sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to conduct phone interviews with any Entrant in order to clarify any information in his or her Entry. Sponsor reserves the right to extend any portion of the Contest or to modify the number of Finalists if it determines, in its sole discretion that some or all of the Eligible Entries received did not meet the minimum qualification standards based on the Judging Criteria specified herein.

The Finalists will be announced each week on or around the dates set forth in Section 2. Finalists must prove eligibility as a condition of being deemed a Finalist. Sponsor will make up to two (2) attempts over the twenty-four (24) hour period following the Finalists' selection to contact the potential Finalists by email and/or by phone (if Entrant has opted to provide a phone number). If a potential Finalist cannot be reached during the twenty-four (24) hour period in which he/she is called (no messages will be left on answering machines or voicemail systems) such potential Finalist will be disqualified and an alternate potential Finalist will be selected from among the remaining Eligible Entries applying the Judging Criteria set forth in this Section 6. Minors must provide proof of consent of a parent or legal guardian as a condition of being deemed a Finalist. In addition, Sponsor reserves the right to select an alternate Finalist from among all Eligible Entries in the event that a potential Finalist fails to comply with these Official Rules. ANY VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES BY A FINALIST OR POTENTIAL GRAND PRIZE WINNER AS DETERMINED BY SPONSOR IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION) WILL RESULT IN SUCH FINALIST'S/POTENTIAL WINNER'S DISQUALIFICATION AS A FINALIST /POTENTIAL GRAND PRIZE WINNER OF THE CONTEST AND ALL PRIVILEGES AS A POTENTIAL FINALIST/ WINNER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED.

7. Voting to Determine the Weekly Winners and the Grand Prize Winner: During the Weekly Voting Periods, the three (3) weekly Finalists' Videos will showcased online on the Contest Website to be voted on by the public. (Videos will be moderated prior to broadcast to confirm compliance with the submission guidelines). At the conclusion of each Weekly Voting Period, the votes for the Finalists' Videos will be tabulated by Sponsor and the one (1) Video that has received the most votes will be declared the winning weekly Video. For the Grand Prize

Voting Period, each of the Videos of the Weekly Winners will be showcased online on the Contest Website to be voted on by the public and at the conclusion of the Grand Prize Voting Period, the votes for the Weekly Winners' Videos will be tabulated by Sponsor and the one (1) Video that has received most votes will be declared the Grand Prize winning Video. Each Winner will be considered a provisional Winner until such time that Winner has confirmed eligibility to the satisfaction of the Sponsor. If, in the event of a tie or a dispute or, for any reason, the voting process is interrupted for any reason, or is found to have been tampered with in any way, Sponsor reserves the right to select the Winners based on the Judging Criteria and/or at its discretion, may take into consideration the number of votes received by a Video up until the time of the interruption or cancelation of the voting process. Entrants are prohibited from obtaining votes by any fraudulent or inappropriate means, including, without limitation, offering prizes or other inducements to members of the public, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. No software-generated, robotic, programmed, script, macro or other automated votes are permitted. In the event that there is an insufficient number of Eligible Entries, Sponsor reserves the right to modify the total number of Finalists/Winners.

8. **Finalists/ Winner Verification:** Each potential Finalist must prove eligibility, including, without limitation, proof of age and residence, social security or resident alien identification number, within forty-eight (48) hours of being notified as a potential Finalist. In the event of non-compliance by a potential Finalist such potential Finalist shall be disqualified and all privileges otherwise due as a Finalist shall be terminated and an alternate potential Finalist may be chosen from among all of the remaining Eligible Entries received, if time permits, in Sponsor's sole discretion. Each potential Finalist (and his/her parent or legal guardian, if a Minor) must sign within forty-eight (48) receipt of such documents from Sponsors: (a) an affidavit of eligibility and release of Sponsor and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, members, affiliated companies and subsidiaries, from any and all liability, loss, claims, demands, and causes of action for personal injury and/or damage, theft, loss, or any other harm suffered in connection with this Contest and (b) except where prohibited, a promotional release granting Sponsor the right to use his/her name and likeness, signature, voice and biography for advertising and publicity purpose without additional compensation. Each potential Finalist agrees to the foregoing and in addition each Finalist agrees to obtain, upon request of Sponsors any additional documentation and releases necessary to prove his/her unrestricted ownership in all materials contained in his/her entry and Sponsors' right to use such entry, in whole or in part, without limitation in all media and for any purpose whatsoever without compensation or further obligation to the Finalist. In addition, if selected as a Winner, the Finalist must also complete any additional legal documents provided by Sponsor (or third party on its behalf, if applicable) with respect to the Prize, including a W2 form and Winner's social security number if required for tax purposes and return them as instructed within the time frame specified by Sponsors or such Finalist may forfeit the Prize at Sponsor's sole discretion. 9. **Prizes:** The one (1) Grand Prize Winner will receive a cash prize of \$500.00 (the "Grand Prize") and each of the eight (8) Weekly Winners will receive a cash prize of \$200.00 (the "Weekly Prize(s)") and together with the Grand Prize, the "Prizes"). The approximate retail value (the "ARV") of all Prizes to be awarded in this Contest is \$2,100.00.

Prizes are non-transferable, non-negotiable.

10. **General Prize Terms:** Prizes will be awarded by Sponsor in the form of a company check or gift card within approximately four (4) weeks of the selection and verification of the Winners.

Sponsor is not responsible if Winner is unavailable or unwilling to accept a Prize.

Winner assumes full responsibility for his or her Prize. If for any reason whatsoever, a Winner is unable accept his/her designated Prize, Sponsor shall have no further obligation to him/her. Sponsor is not responsible for any cancellations, delays, diversions or substitutions, or any act or omission whatsoever with respect to the prizing. Winner will be solely responsible for paying all applicable federal, state or local taxes on prize based upon the

value of the Prize received as set forth in these Official Rules and will be issued an IRS form 1099 for the value as published in these Official Rules.

11. **General Terms:** Noncompliance with any of these Official Rules may result in disqualification. ANY VIOLATION OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES BY A WINNER OR ANY BEHAVIOR BY A WINNER THAT WILL BRING SUCH WINNER OR ANY OF THE CONTEST ENTITIES INTO DISREPUTE (AS DETERMINED BY THE AFFECTED CONTEST ENTITY IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION WILL RESULT IN SUCH WINNER'S DISQUALIFICATION AS A WINNER OF THE CONTEST AND ALL PRIVILEGES AS A WINNER WILL BE IMMEDIATELY TERMINATED.

Contest Entities assume no responsibility for incorrect or inaccurate entry information whether caused by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in this Contest or by any human error which may occur in the processing of the Entries or the votes in this Contest. Contest Entities are not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any e-mail or players on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website, or any combination thereof, or any incomplete, lost, late, delayed, misdirected or garbled votes or failure to receive votes, including, without limitation, any injury or damage to participant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in this Contest. Contest Entities are not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing of the offer, administration of the Contest, or in the announcement of the Prizes or the Winners. If, for any reason, the Contest is not capable of running as planned, including, without limitation, changes in VMN's on-air programming, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of Contest Entities which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest or for any reason that the Contest Entities deem it necessary, Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest, and to determine the Winners in their sole discretion. Should the Contest be modified or terminated prior to the stated expiration date, notice will be posted on the Contest Website and the Prizes may be awarded to a winner to be selected from among all Eligible Entries received up until and/or after (if applicable) the time of modification, cancellation or termination, or in a manner that is fair and equitable as determined by Sponsor. All interpretations of these Official Rules by Sponsor and decisions of Sponsor are final. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it suspects or finds: (a) to be acting in violation of these Official Rules; (b) to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person; or (c) to have provided inaccurate information on any legal documents submitted in connection with this Contest.

CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY ANY INDIVIDUAL TO DELIBERATELY UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, SPONSOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES FROM ANY SUCH INDIVIDUAL TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. Entrants agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Contest Entities and each of their respective affiliated companies, parents, sponsors, subsidiaries, officers, directors, employees, agents, members (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties") from and against any and all liabilities, claims, suits, losses, damages, expenses and costs (including, but not limited to reasonable attorneys' fees) resulting or arising from: (i) the Contest, (ii) any breach or violation of any representation, warranty, obligation or covenant made by each Entrant herein, (iii) the acceptance, possession, use, misuse, or nonuse of any prize; or (iv) participating in or traveling to any Contest-related activity; and each Entrant agrees to release all rights to bring any claim, action or proceeding against the Indemnified Parties, and hereby acknowledge that the Indemnified Parties have neither made nor are in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to the Prizes.
